She is a DVM with more than ten years of experience in zoonotic diseases, a PhD in Veterinary Science, a Master's in International Cooperation and a specialization school in Veterinary Public Health and Livestock production. GA is a veterinary researcher at the Research and International Cooperation Department of IZSVE. In the last ten years, she has been involved in several research projects and surveillance activities, mainly in Northern and Central Italy, and in cooperation projects in North-West Africa, Eastern European Countries, the Balkans and the Middle East as an expert on infectious diseases and public health. She performs surveillance plans, epidemiological studies, and studies on the social impact of animal diseases and social factors affecting transboundary animal diseases spread, awareness campaigns and the creation of communication tools. In addition, Dr Angeloni has proven experience in project management, coordination and liaison between partners and donors at the Italian and international levels (e.g. H2020 project, EU twinning, WOAAH projects).
